13 important things to know about Electrical Safety

1. Electricity is always looking for a GROUND- Don't become the ground!
2. Don't work on Live Circuits, if you don't have to !
3. Water means danger- Keep Cords & Equipment DRY!
4. If you must work on a Live Circuit or near Energized Equipment- Use PPE!
5. Aluminum Ladders are illegal for Electricians or Demolition work where potential for Live Power exists.
6. GFCI Protection is required and must be tested that it works!
7. Only a Qualified Electrician can install or alter a Temp Power system!
8. Insulated Tools, Mats and Rubber Gloves must be used if you work where potential for Live Power exists!
9. Overhead Power Line clearance is minimum 10ft – 15ft is better and 20 ft is even better!
Post signs near the Power Lines to inform others!
10. Lock Out Tag Out is required!
11. Electrical Panels must be locked!
12. Don't assume the Power is dead! Test the circuit even after you Lock it Out.
13. A 110 volt circuit can kill !
