10 important things you should know about Fire Safety

1. A Written Fire Safety Plan is required on every job where potential FIRE hazards exist.
2. Smoking is not allowed in buildings under Construction or within 50 ft of flammables.
3. A Fire Extinguisher is required at each floor level near the Stairwell.
4. A Fire Extinguisher is required every 75 ft. of open floor area.
5. No more than 5 gal. of gasoline or other flammables are allowed at any one location inside of a building. 25 gal. maximum at all locations combined.
6. All flammables and combustibles must be properly stored in an NFPA approved FLAMMABLES (metal) cabinet at the end of shift.
7. Safety cans are required when dispensing flammable liquids.
8. Employees must be trained annually in the use of Fire Extinguishers.
9. Access to Fire Extinguishers must be kept clear and visible. Mounted on stands!
10. **Good Housekeeping is the BEST way to prevent a fire !**
