10 things you should know about Power Tool safety

1. If it came with a safety guard, you must not remove it.
2. You must train employees how to use tools safely.
3. Unplug the tool when changing bits, blades and dies etc
4. If the drill is ½ " or larger, you must use the safety leverage handle.
5. When using a ladder and a power tool, maintain 3 point contact with the ladder. It's safer to use a scissor lift or scaffold!
6. Loose clothing, long hair and jewelry are a bad idea when using power tools
7. Pneumatic nail guns are dangerous and training is required.
8. Powder actuated nail guns are dangerous and certified training is required.
9. Don't carry power tools with your finger on the trigger.
10. Read the manufacturers safety instructions!
